Rain Policy

The officiating body will consist of the club professional and the league commissioner.

Play will be stopped if there is a danger to participants or weather/course conditions are such that the course is considered unplayable.

The officiating body will make the decision to either temporarily suspend play or terminate the round.

Should the officiating body decide to temporarily suspend play due to danger to participants or weather/course conditions, all players will return to clubhouse for the duration of the delay.

Should any player decide not to continue play without the round being terminated by the officiating body, the player will be disqualified and the player's score will not count toward the team score.

At least 2 players are required to continue participation by the group. If only one player wishes to continue play, that player unfortunately is also disqualified.

If play is terminated and the field has completed 9 or more holes, the officiating body may declare the round a 9 hole event. Scoring of 18 hole players will be based upon the first 9 holes played.

All scorecards must be turned into the **pro shop** whether or not play for the group was terminated or completed.
